



Refund Policy

Please be advised that all refund requests must be submitted in writing to our summer school team. The registration fee is non-refundable. Refunds will be processed within 3-4 weeks of receipt of a valid request.

For tuition refunds, the following policies apply:

- If a student withdraws by May 30, the tuition will be refunded less any commission fees or bank transaction charges.
- 50% of the tuition fee will be refundable before the start of the program, less any commission fees or bank transaction charges.
- From the official start of the program, no refund will be available.
